

GONE...BUT NOT FORGOTTEN

rrim forgives and it may also give oldsmobile new business in future



One advantage to reinforced reaction injection molded parts is a forgiving nature. Here, in a pendulum test, a sleel weight (a) hits the fender. (b) the fender bounces back, (c) with no apparent damage. Other advantages are lighter weight and no corrosion.

A forgiving material used to mold some automotive fenders and fascia may hold one of the keys to Oldsmobile's future.

Reinforced reaction injection molding (RRIM for short) produced a friendly fender last year, and flexing front and rear fascia and fenders for 1982 models. Already projects for future models, including some for other GM divisions, have been given final approval.

And according to Larry Lennon, master mechanic in production engineering, in future model years more and more RRIM parts are being specified.

Oldsmobile is the only large scale rnanufacturer of reinforced RIM. Last rnodel year when the division introduced the Sport Omega with flex fenders, Oldsmobile became the first auto company to use the material for production parts.

Due to the pioneering nature of Oldsmobile involvement with RRIM, the division and a few select vendors liave done most of the development work in both materials and equipment.

The material is formed from two

resins reinforced with milled fiberglass. The resins provide the flexing ability and the addition of fiberglass gives the parts integrity and prevents sag and distortion.

Building 78 has been turned into the RRIM production facility. Four clamps and related pieces of equipment used to mold the material are already installed. Four others are awaiting installation and three more are on order.

Nearly 50 employes are working in the RRIM area now.

RRIM parts provide auto designers

a number of advantages including light weight, no corrosion and flexing back after minor impacts.

"Paint for RRIM must be flexible. If it weren't the part would flex back after impact but the paint would flake off," Lennon explained.

A flexible acrylic enamel is used, similar to the paint on urethane bumper fillers and soft fascia but very different than that currently used on sheet metal.

"More and more the auto industry is going to frame integral where body parts are hung on a frame and often it is then that the car is painted. That is not possible with our current RRIM," he added.

"There is a future for RRIM but as always when you're on the leading edge of development you encounter problems that must be resolved," Lennon added. "I think we have to sell our own product. We have to convince engineers and designers to try RRIM."


As more new cars, new in the sense they have been designed on clean paper, are developed, Lennon sees the RRIM star rising.

"RRIM becomes more of a possibility when you completely rethink a car. It has definite advantages to designers, to engineers and to the customer," he added.

Lennon is committed to having the problems solved when more designs of the future call for RRIM.

Oldsmobile's 1982 Firenza becomes the first car in the industry to feature reinforced reaction injection molded (RRIM) fascia. The material was chosen to reduce distortion in the fascia itself. Rather than using shock absorbers on the front bumper, Oldsmobile engineers specified a plastic energy absorber backed by an impact bar.
